



What is LAMP?

LAMP is an independent program that works directly with families in order to support Homeschool families like our own. Coordinators, Donald and Jessica Korff, have been homeschooling for over 15 years and have uncovered so many opportunities in their journey of homeschooling, and it is their heart to share that with the families that feel called to the same path of homeschooling that they have been. LAMP is the program created in order to step toward that mission. Over a dozen PIONEERS families participated in the LAMP program receiving assistance with their PIO tuition during the 2022-23 co-op year!

How does it work?

LAMP has a variety of different program options for families to sign up for, all designed around the flexible needs and interests of the homeschool family. In addition to the variety of programs that LAMP has to offer, there is also a sponsorship program that compliments the other components. Simply put, a family signs up each child to participate in a LAMP program option, and through that participation, the child becomes eligible take part in the unique in-person classes offered by the LAMP Team, to participate in monthly field trips, and to be sponsored toward taking other outside classes in the community like **PIONEERS Co-op**, YMCA classes, Kid's Gym, or music lessons of some sort. It is all designed to support and extend the opportunities for homeschool families in a way that just works!

What is the Cost?

Lamp will cover Pioneer tuition up to approximately \$121/month per student for those students participating in PIONEERS K-12th programs. Families participating in the LAMP program will be responsible for a \$25 processing fee, payable to PIONEERS, for the extra processing associated with and generated by LAMP funding.

All families attending PIONEERS are expected to pay tuition promptly at the beginning of each month. As LAMP tuition payments to PIONEERS do not begin until 2 weeks after the first month of PIONEERS (e.g. the second week of October), this delay in payment creates a lack of funding for PIONEERS during the month of September. For this reason, all LAMP families will be responsible to self-pay their September tuition bill no later than the first week that we meet in September. When the first LAMP payment is received in October (usually the second week), that payment will be applied to each family's October tuition bill. Any money left over at the end of the year (June) will be applied towards the following year's bills. Families not returning to PIONEERS the following school year will forfeit this money.

Please be reminded that LAMP funds are only applicable to tuition and can NOT be used to pay lab/supply fees. All PIONEER families are responsible to pay their own lab/supply fees when they are invoiced at the end of July.
